Bethel Local Schools



Carriage Trails is located in the Bethel Local School District, which includes portions of Tipp City, Huber Heights and Bethel Township, Ohio. The public school system is rated Excellent by the State of Ohio Standards for K – 12 Education, accredited by the State of Ohio and the North Central Association and **recently received a Performance Index Grade of B with a high index average in the Ohio School District Ranking Study out of over 800 schools.** A traditional school system, the district's curriculum offers college prep as well as vocational and general courses of studies. The students and parents (with a strong PTO, Athletic Boosters and surrounding support of the community) take great pride in their academic and extracurricular accomplishments.



The mission of Bethel Local Schools is “to educate with excellence, inspiring each student to become a responsible, contributing citizen in local and world communities.”

Over the next 5 years, projections show that Bethel Schools expect to add between 200-400 students, with the most growth coming from Carriage Trails. Therefore, with the passing of the 2013 Bethel Bond Levy, the Bethel Local School District can now add on to the existing K-12 building to make room for this growth. To date, Bethel schools includes approximately 609 elementary, 167 junior high and 329 high school students, with a total enrollment of 1,105 students. “Bethel is building for new growth...”

Bethel Local School graduates consistently rank among the top in the Miami Valley area in proficiency and achievement tests and over half go on to colleges and universities. Graduates earned more than \$732,215 in scholarships and awards to public and private colleges and universities in Ohio and the nation in 2013-2014. Each year, Carriage Trails at The Heights offers two motivated high school seniors from both Bethel High School and Wayne High School, a \$500 scholarship to help in furthering their education.
